### THE HISTORY

Formerly known as the Price Hill Masonic Lodge, ARCO is an award-winning, \$10 million restoration project co-developed by local nonprofit, Price Hill Will and the Model Group in 2014.

Originally built in 1912, the Samuel Hannaford-designed building was home to the Price Hill Masons for several years before becoming vacant in the 1980s. In 2019, work to bring the 21,000 square foot, local historic landmark back to life officially began. By the summer of 2020, all major renovations were complete.

The complex financial structure which made the renovation possible included New Market Tax Credits, Historic Tax Credits, a \$2.9 million grant from the City of Cincinnati, and equity from Price Hill Will. This was bridged by loans from Local Initiatives Support Corporation, Cincinnati Development Fund, and The Port.

The fully renovated building currently holds office space for Price Hill Will, rehearsal space for their 120-member MYCincinnati youth orchestra and Price Hillharmonic's adult orchestra, and leasable space for local non-profits, neighborhood groups, community events, and private celebrations.

# THE PURPOSE

ARCO is a space for people to connect, learn from each other, and share a common interest via the arts and performance, events and celebrations, community council meetings, and more.






Shawnee Theater, located on the first floor, features an original 16 foot deep orchestral-style stage with 27 foot long railing, engineered hardwood floors, an automatic stage curtain, performance lighting, acoustic paneling and professionally wired performance sound.



Myaamia Hall, located on the third floor, features a 32ft stage with accompanying platforms around the perimeter, three panels of sky-light stained glass, original wood floors, four point lighting, acoustic paneling, a portable sound system, and an adjacent hallway call the "Iris Gallery."



Iris Gallery features three 12ft high windows with Florentine glass restored during the renovation. The original hardwood and wood trim frames the space for the rotating artists gallery and creates a subtle backdrop for quests waiting to enter Myaamia Hall. The north facing gallery is also perfect for professional or amateur film shooting.

ARCO quite literally means arts and community. Our goal is to bring together residents of the neighborhood to foster understanding and community engagement through the visual and performing arts, educational classes & workshops, family-friendly events, and more.


